Free meals at Minneapolis food hall this weekend

Eat Street Crossing food hall, located two blocks away from where Alex Pretti was killed, will give away 500 free meals this weekend as a way to give back to the community.

“What happened down the street from us broke all of our hearts,” Marshall Nguyen, one of ESC’s partners, told the Minnesota Star Tribune. “When a community is hurting, you show up and take care of people.”

To participate, stop by the Minneapolis food hall at 2819 Nicollet Av. beginning Tuesday to pick up a coupon, which can be redeemed for a select entree and a beverage Friday through Sunday while supplies last.

All vendors — Staff Meeting, House of Hue, Hikari Hand Roll Bar, El Sazon, Niko Niko Boba and Bebe Zito Ice Cream — will be participating.

“We invite anyone who needs a warm meal, a safe space, or simply a reminder that they are supported to come by,” said an Instagram post announcing the event, which is sponsored by Saigon Nights, Eat Street Crossing and private donors. “Let’s lift each other up, feed our neighbors, and stand together through the hard moments.”
