

Help if you are Self-Employed (Sch C Filers without Employees)

You are eligible for many of the same programs as larger businesses, although some of the calculations and qualifications might be slightly different.

- If your work has been cut, you can apply for the [Economic Injury Disaster Loan \(EIDL\)](#).
- You will also be eligible for the [Paycheck Protection Program](#), although you can't apply until April 10. Contact your lender now to be first in line.
 - Our understanding is that your net profits are treated as “wages” to meet the definition of “paycheck” but we are awaiting further clarification

- If you primarily contract for one company, there is a possibility that they could still pay you if they benefit from one of these programs.
- Unemployment compensation has been expanded, so [check with your state](#) to see if you qualify.
