
Investment Thoughts

The average S&P 500 total return is 10% per year but the stock market has only performed within 2% of that number in only 4 of the last 97 years. The highest annual return was +53% and lowest -44%. The lesson? To get the average return, stay diversified and hang on.-Peter Mallouk




Mega Roth 401k plans

The classic 401k plan involves putting money pretax into the plan and deducting it from your income for tax purposes until withdrawn. There is also a typical Roth 401k, where after tax funds are put towards the salary deferral side. We don't recommend these for families with higher income. But, some companies are adding a feature to their 401k plans in that you are allowed to contribute <u>after tax</u> funds toward the <u>employer</u> portion of the account. The after tax funds so contributed can then be (and should be) moved out each year to a Roth IRA where they will grow tax free forever. Check with your company plan to see if this feature has been added and let us know. It is rare (we've only seen it once so far), but changing in frequency.

New: Allowing retirement plans to own "alts"

President Trump has signed an executive order to allow retirement plans to own what are known as alternative investments. These investments usually fall into the categories of private equity, private real estate ownership and loans, structured notes and more. We are very familiar with alternative investments and will always be looking for attractive purchases. At the present, everything is new and we are certain there will be more dangerous than lucrative



opportunities. Many of these offerings are not liquid (can take years to get your money out) and you don't get paid enough for that feature. We are always happy to discuss any of this with you and will let you know if we think you should have something in your portfolio.

We always will buy a new investment in our own portfolios before considering it for others. It has to be something we'd own ourselves in order to buy it for you. Two recent examples are GSIMX (Goldman Sachs international stocks) which we thought would offer some active management skill in less efficient emerging markets. We see good results over five years, but not so much over shorter terms and we are watching it closely. We also bought GRHIX in many portfolios to participate in the global thirst for energy (doing well!). We hold some aggressive fixed income for some of you (and us- such as PDI) and we are always thinking about how to increase total earnings while minimizing long term risk.



A cutting-edge gene therapy has significantly restored hearing in children and adults with congenital deafness, showing dramatic results just one month after a single injection.

Researchers used a virus to deliver a healthy copy of the OTOF gene into the inner ear, improving auditory function across all ten participants in the study. The therapy worked best in young children but still benefited adults, with one 7-year-old girl regaining almost full hearing. 
