Feeding America – A national food bank that supports local food banks such as the Oregon Food Bank and Greater Boston Food Bank.

Habitat for Humanity – A global organization focusing on building communities by developing and renovating housing.

Additionally, we supported the following organizations –

American Indian College Fund – Invests in Native student higher education by funding and creating awareness of the unique community-based accredited tribal colleges and universities.

The Library Foundation – (Multnomah County, Portland, Oregon) – Enhances leadership, innovation and reach, helping the library address emerging community needs through private support. Our support has been directed to literacy programs.

Portland State Foundation – The Nancy Ryles Scholarship – Assists women whose education has been interrupted and who wish to return to college to earn a degree.

Trailkeepers of Oregon – (Portland Oregon) – Founded in 2007 by a group of concerned hikers who wanted to restore threatened trails, create hiker awareness and ensure public land managers provide adequate protections for our trails.
