An independent judging panel made up of industry experts determines the winners of these awards by examining both qualitative and quantitative performance indicators. In order to be considered for a PAM Award, MQS must submit an award application to PAM containing requested information for the prior twelve months. All judges are required to sign a disclaimer form to keep information about entries and the final winners confidential. The judges are selected by PAM on the basis of their experience and expertise, as well as their absence of conflicts of interest. Judges cannot judge any categories that their company has submitted for and are obliged to declare that they have no conflicts of interest prior to judging.
