

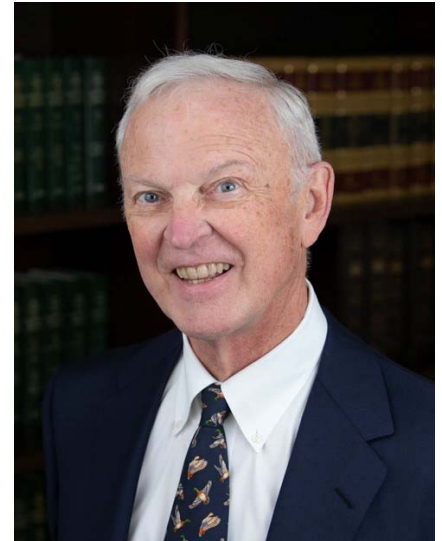
David B. Sweeney
