Investment Strategy

The investment seeks to preserve capital and maximize total return. The fund invests primarily in U.S. dollar denominated fixed income securities that the Advisor believes are undervalued. It may invest in all types of fixed income securities but will typically invest in fixed income securities such as corporate bonds, U.S. government securities and mortgage-backed securities. At least 80% of its net assets (including the amount of any borrowings for investment purposes) will be invested in fixed income investments, which include fixed income securities and shares of other RICs that invest primarily in fixed income securities.

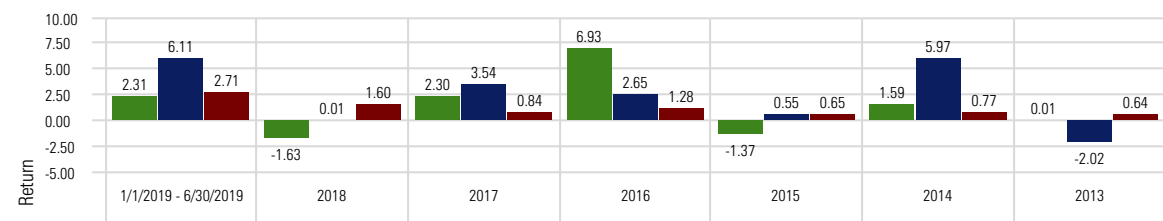

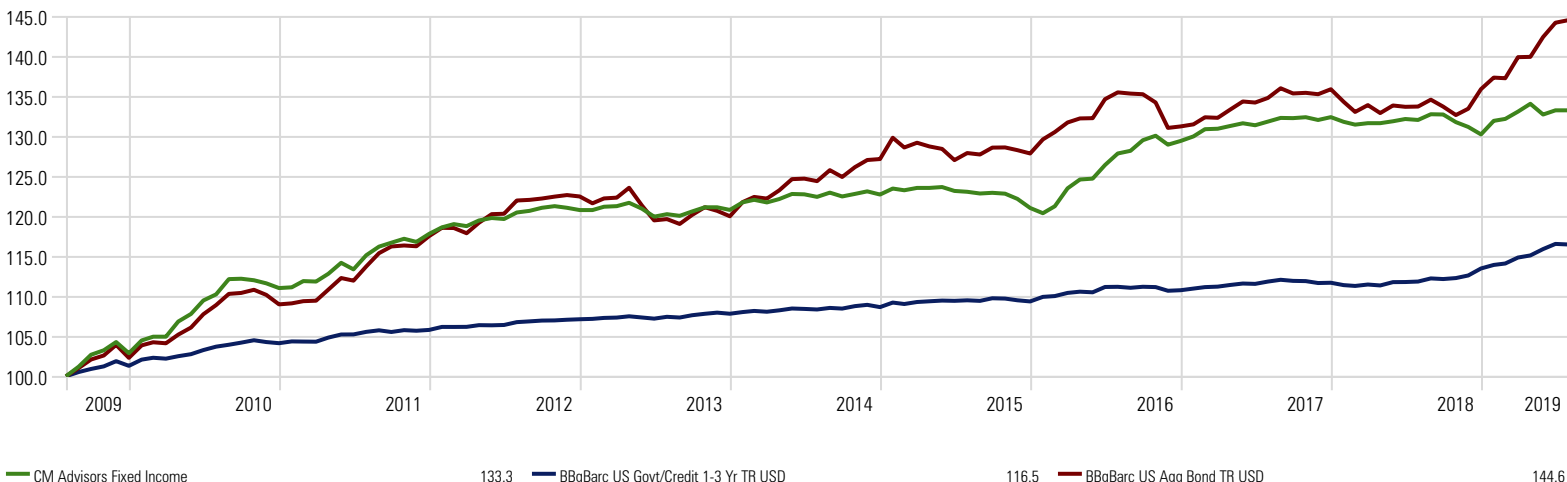

The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or “star rating”, is calculated for managed products (including mutual funds, variable annuity and variable life subaccounts, exchange-traded funds, closed-end funds, and separate accounts) with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar RiskAdjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product’s monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star. The Overall Morningstar Rating for a managed product is derived from a weighted average of the performance figures associated with its three-, five-, and 10-year (if applicable) Morningstar Rating metrics. The weights are: 100% three-year rating for 36-59 months of total returns, 60% five-year rating/40% three-year rating for 60-119 months of total returns, and 50% 10-year rating/30% five-year rating/20% three-year rating for 120 or more months of total returns. While the 10-year overall star rating formula seems to give the most weight to the 10-year period, the most recent three-year period actually has the greatest impact because it is included in all three rating periods. The **Average Maturity** is computed by weighting the maturity of each security in the portfolio by the market value of the security, then averaging these weighted figures. The **Average Coupon** is the interest rate stated on a bond when it is issued. The **Average Duration** is a time measure of a bond’s interest-rate sensitivity, based on the weighted average of the time periods over which a bond’s cash flows accrue to the bondholder. Time periods are weighted by multiplying by the present value of its cash flow divided by the bond’s price. (A bond’s cash flows consist of coupon payments and repayment of capital.) A bond’s duration will almost always be shorter than its maturity, with the exception of zero-coupon bonds, for which maturity and duration are equal. The **Morningstar Credit Rating** is sourced from Standard & Poors (“S&P”) Global Rating. **Alpha** is the excess return of the fund relative to the return of the benchmark index. **Beta** is a measure of the volatility, or systematic risk, of a security or a portfolio in comparison to the market as a whole. **R2 (R-Squared)** is a statistical measure that represents the percentage of a fund’s movement that can be explained by movements in the benchmark index. **Tracking Error** is a divergence between the price behavior of a position or a portfolio and the price behavior of a benchmark. **Information Ratio** is a ratio of portfolio returns above the returns of a benchmark to the volatility of those returns. **Excess Return** is the investment returns from a security or portfolio that exceed a benchmark with a similar level of risk. **Standard Deviation** is a measure of the dispersion of a set of data from its mean. **Sharpe Ratio** is the average return in excess of the risk-free rate per unit of volatility or total risk. **Sortino Ratio** is a variation of the Sharpe ratio that differentiates harmful volatility from total volatility by using the asset’s standard deviation of negative asset returns, called downside deviation.
