

Cookie Policy Notice

Our Cookie Policy explains how we collect and use information from and about you when you visit our website, fill-out form information, download marketing materials, or otherwise interact with us. This policy explains more about how we use cookies and your choices concerning cookies.

What Are Cookies?

A "cookie" is a small text file that is downloaded onto your device such as a computer or smartphone when you access our website. They may be served by the entity that operates the website you are visiting ("first-party cookies") or by other companies ("third-party cookies"). For example, we partner with third-party analytics providers, like Google, which set cookies when you visit our website.

Our website uses two types of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary and are erased when you close your browser at the end of your surfing session. We use session cookies for website functionality, such as recognizing users so any page changes or data selection you do is remembered from page to page. Persistent cookies are not removed when you exit your web browser and remain on your hard drive until you erase them, or they expire. We use persistent cookies to help us remember your information and settings when you visit our website in the future. This results in faster and more convenient access.

How And Why Use Cookies?

Like most websites, we use cookies for a number of reasons, like helping us see what content is most popular, counting visitors to a page, keeping our services secure, and generally providing you with a better experience.

When we send you an email, we may use cookies to understand if you have accessed the information provided in the email. We may combine information collected through the cookies with your Personal Information in order to provide you a personalized experience including advertising our services you may find of interest. The information we collect from cookies also may allow us to identify you across devices, such as smartphones, tablets, computers or related browsers.

How To Manage Your Cookie Preferences

You have a number of options to control or limit how we and our partners use cookies and similar technologies.

- Although most browsers and devices accept cookies by default, their settings usually allow you to clear or decline cookies. If you disable cookies, however, some of the features of our services may not function properly.
- To prevent your data from being used by Google Analytics, you can install Google's opt-out browser add-on.
- To opt-out of ads on social media and Google that are targeted to your interests, please use that specific website's settings.
- Check your mobile device for settings that control ads based on your interactions with the applications on your device. For example, on your iOS device, enable the "Limit Ad Tracking" setting, and on your Android device, enable the "Opt-out of Ads Personalization" setting.

Managing cookie preferences differs from browser to browser so please refer to your browser for further information. If you would like to disable cookies, please use the help function in your web browser to restrict cookies from our website.
