# Room-by-Room Home Assessment Tool

# **General Home Safety**

Item	Check	Notes / Actions Needed
Walkways are free of clutter or cords		
Floors are in good condition, without loose rugs or uneven edges		
Lighting is bright and consistent throughout rooms and hallways		
Smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors are installed and working		
Emergency numbers are visible and easy to reach		
Stairs have sturdy railings on both sides		
There is a clear and safe exit route in case of emergency		

### **Entryway / Exterior**

Item	Check	Notes / Actions Needed
Pathway and driveway are even and well lit		
Entryway is free from obstacles and tripping hazards		
Door locks are easy to use and secure		
Thresholds are low or beveled for easy access		
Handrails or grab bars are present where needed		

# **Living Room**

Item	Check	Notes / Actions Needed
Furniture is arranged to allow clear walking paths		
Coffee tables and cords do not block movement		
Seating is firm and high enough to make standing easier		
Lighting is adequate for reading and evening use		
Area rugs are non-slip or secured		

### Kitchen

Item	Check	Notes / Actions Needed
Commonly used items are stored within easy reach (no need for step stool)		
Stove and oven controls are clearly marked and easy to use		
Fire extinguisher is accessible and in working order		
Refrigerator and pantry are organized and food is within reach		
Floor is dry, even, and non-slippery		
Adequate lighting for meal preparation		

### **Bedroom**

Item	Check	Notes / Actions Needed
Path from bed to bathroom is clear and well lit		
Bed height allows for easy sitting and standing		
Telephone or alert system within reach of the bed		
Lighting can be controlled from bed		
No clutter or loose cords on the floor		

#### **Bathroom**

Item	Check	Notes / Actions Needed
Grab bars installed near toilet and shower/tub		
Non-slip mats or surfaces in shower and tub		
Shower chair or handheld showerhead available (if needed)		
Toilet height is comfortable and accessible		
Floor remains dry; no water leakage		
Bright, glare-free lighting		

### **Laundry Area**

Washer and dryer are easy to reach and operate	d			
Laundry supplies stored at waist height too high or low)	(not			
Floor is clear and dry				
Hallways and Stairs
